- The Race Support Contracts System Racebiztility is on hold for the moment until after the Market Street Mile.

## **Competition** - Jill Cameron

Grand Prix, Equalizer, and Trail series are going well.

## Store - Josh Roane

ACTION: Josh Roane will bring samples of shirts to training programs.

- Car seat covers are the best seller. The Last order had a defect issue which was resolved by the manufacturer.
- Seeking ideas for new items. The unofficial training program logo is popular.
- Discussed "coach" shirts to help participants identify coaches at training programs.

ACTION: Josh Roane will follow through on coach shirt.

## Race Support - Mark Lawrence

- Discussion of current process for advertising for races. Race directors are
  responsible for putting details onto the FSRC website calendar. Not all race directors
  do however. The definitive race list is in the spreadsheet, not the calendar. Currently
  Harriet Langlois is checking for differences between the spreadsheet and web
  calendar and following up with race directors to be sure the calendar entry gets
  made.
- Current city race courses are problematic overly expensive for local races due to new requirements to hire traffic control officers.

ACTION: Lou King is working with Director of Parks and Recreation (Bob Smith) to design a new course for the City of Frederick that is fully on public streets.

 The current City of Frederick race permitting process is problematic, particularly for small races.

ACTION: Mark Lawrence and Lou King are working with the City of Frederick to improve the process for race permitting.

- In general, numbers are down for smaller local races, perhaps due to other larger races saturating the market. This affects FSRC positively race services schedule more manageable and negatively reduced income.
- Stone Mill and JFK are on the same day in 2018. Usual JFK aid station volunteers may be running Stone Mill.

ACTION: Jill Cameron will advertise for JFK aid station.

# **Women's Distance Festival** - Harriet Langlois

- Race went well except for timing. Sponsorships, registrations, and net revenue all hit all-time highs.
- 2I Timing out of Gettysburg performed poorly. Primary timing system had 100% failure on start chip reads, 75% failure on finish chip reads. Backup system missed over 100 runners. Many results were filled in as gun time from the video. The company didn't explain how bad the situation was at the race. Lack of honesty is a deal breaker for next year.

ACTION: Harriet Langlois will find a new timing company for the 2019 Women's Distance Festival 5k.

- Netted approximately \$24400.
- Having non-profits set up at expo worked well.

## Market Street Mile - Lou King

The donation button on RunSignUp is being utilized and netted and additional \$500.

Signature race advertising cards seem to have excess leftover. A single card advertising all four races rather than four separate cards was proposed.

RECOMMENDATION: Consider other strategies for efficient use of advertising materials.

### Rick's Run

Participant numbers are down compared to this time last year (83 versus 125). This may be due to a number of factors. There are several locally popular races on the same weekend including Patapsco and the Women's Half Marathon by VHTRC. Also, Kevin Sayers hosted a new ultra race in Spring 2018 that used the identical course.
