- Louis Schiavone will be taking over as the Communication Committee Chair.
- Jill Cameron has advertised for, and received, volunteers for the JFK aid station. A generator has been donated to the club for use at JFK, and future needs.
- UNCOMPLETED ACTION: Harriet Langlois did not follow up with Margaret Osborne, but FSRC did promote the race which is now over.
- Louis Schiavone wrote article about the Women's Distance Festival.
- Harriet Langlois and Lou King have proposals from 7 to 8 timing companies.

2018-Q3 Budget vs Actual.pdf

- Overall, financials are healthy.
- Income approximately \$1800 above budget.
- Race management finish line revenue down as expected, secondary to number of races serviced dropping.
- Women's Distance Festival donated \$24471 to the Women's Giving Circle.
- Market Street Mile donated \$11654 to the Student Homelessness Initiative Partnership.
- Rick's Run added \$7127 to the Memorial Scholarship Fund.
- FSRC is past due for a full financial review.

ACTION: Harriet Langlois to insure new leadership is aware of process to complete financial review in 2019.

RECOMMENDATION: Committee leads need to provide input to 2019 budget process if needs are significantly different from 2018.

ACTION: Harriet Langlois will solicit for 2019 budget input.

Panthers - Jill Cameron

Josh Henson is seeking coaches for the spring.

Racing Team - Chris Van Sant

- The Racing Team had 13 Boston qualifiers.
- Current racing singlets are not particularly breathable, thus some members choose not to wear them for races.

ACTION: Chris Van Sant to send input to treasurer regarding cost of new singlets.

• Applications for 2019 team open December 1st.

ACTION: Chris Van Sant to coordinate with Communications to notify FSRC members of open application.

Competition Committee - Shannon Matthews

- Competition committee has advertised for and is now accepting nominations for yearly awards.
- 2019 Grand Prix races will be voted on in December.

Newsletter - Roseann Abdu

• Deadline for next edition of Intervals is December 1st.

Public Relations - Jill Cameron

• Summer Solstice 8k article was published by the Frederick News Post

ACTION: Louis Schiavone will look into expanding reach to other local publications. ACTION: Louis Schiavone will continue developing a FSRC Communication Plan.

Rick's Run - FSRC Memorial Scholarship - Crista Horn

- 50+ hornet stings were reported to medical during the first loop of Rick's Run. The issue was dealt with promptly by Park Rangers.
- In 2018 there were only 12 applicants for the FSRC Memorial Scholarship
- Means of increasing the number and quality of the applicant pool were discussed.

RECOMMENDATION: In addition to current methods of advertisement, focus more on direct communication with the high school coaches.

ACTION: Crista Horn will update the FSRC website to reflect more transparent scholarship descriptions and requirements.

Technology - Lou King

ACTION: Lou King to continue with development of "contractility" which will assist with simplifying the FSRC race contracts process.

ACTION: Mike Kearny will take over for Jenny Halberg for calendar support, and racing team "club" scoretility admin. Jenny Halberg will continue with general club scoretility admin.

Market Street Mile - Lou King

• 2018 Market Street Mile was a success despite issues with youth timing, with 690 registrants and \$11654 raised for the Student Homelessness Initiative Partnership.

ACTION: Lou King to start Market Street Mile 15 minutes later in 2019 to allow more time for police to get into position.

ACTION: Lou King will work with In the Street to determine feasibility of adding a Masters' heat to the Market Street Mile.

ACTION: Lou King will continue discussion with the city to determine feasibility of an expo at the finish line of the Market Street Mile.

Community Outreach - Lou King

• Lou King will be stepping down from Community Outreach position.

ACTION: Lou King (and future Community Outreach volunteer) will continue to work with the City of Frederick (Bob Smith) to develop a new course at Riverside Park that does not require police or traffic control. Bob Smith is currently in discussions with the parking lot owners to see if this is feasible.

Membership - Jill Cameron

• 985 members

Education Nights - Pam Geernaert

 Last 4 Education Nights have had very low attendance despite having topics requested by FSRC members.

ACTION: Pam Geernaert to work with Billy Clem and Nicole Davis to determine feasibility of incorporating Education Nights back into the training programs as they were originally.

<u>Connecting New Members</u> - Jill Cameron

• When training programs are not in session, new members have difficulty connecting into group runs. The FSRC Group Runs Facebook page is not currently well utilized.

ACTION: Tim O'Keefe will adjust the pace posted on the website of the Sunday morning run.

ACTION: Officers and committee members present will make an effort to post runs on the FSCR Group Runs Facebook page.

ACTION: Kerry McHugh will seek "FSRC Ambassador" volunteer to send follow-up email to new members regarding activities occurring in next few months after joining.

RECOMMENDATION: Billy Clem will look into starting monthly "pub run" to connect new members to FSRC.

Trail Running - Nicole Davis

• Lil' B 5k-ish slated for April 6, 2019.

ACTION: Nicole Davis to secure permit and continue planning for Lil' B 5k-ish.

Approximately 15 members are hoping to complete their first 50k in 2019.

ACTION: Nicole Davis will connect with first-50k members regarding a loose training program.

Training Programs - Nicole Davis

Spires

- 75 athletes in XC program.
- First home meet was successful. Raised \$1385 in registration fees.
- Track season begins in March.

ACTION: Nicole Davis to assist with finding new coaches for the Spires' spring season.

Coed 5k Training Program

• Program wrapped up with Headless Horseman 5k. Overall feedback was good for inaugural program.

Half Marathon Training Program

 80 participants signed up with 15 completing target races. Overall feedback was good.

Marathon Training Program

- 80 participants signed up with 21% completing program virtually.
- A theft at one of the aid drops resulted in the loss of some clothing and the cooler (belonging to a participant) being used to store aid.

ACTION: Billy Clem to purchase a cooler for each training program and give receipts to Harriet Langlois.

Coaches' meeting to be held December 3rd.

Social - Heidi Novak

- No happy hour for November due to holiday.
- December happy hour will be a Battle of the Brews, hosted by Lou King.

ACTION: Heidi Novak will open up registration for the Year-End Celebration Banquet soon. Lou King will assist as needed.

Reference File: Board of Directors Job Description (pending review)

- A job description is under development for multiple leadership positions, including the Board of Directors to clarify duties and expectations for FSRC members before seeking to fill these positions.
- For the Board of Directors description in particular, the following questions were raised:

- Is it reasonable to have a document describing what is expected of individuals holding the position? Does the presence of this document create a culture where individuals want to participate?
- What is the enforcement mechanism?
- What level of board meeting attendance is necessary for an individual to have sufficient knowledge of FSRC business to vote?
- Does current language reflect obligations of duty of care and fiduciary responsibilities for a 501C-3?

RECOMMENDATION: Hold final discussion of topic until Robert Hall can provide input at February board meeting.

RECOMMENDATION: Adjust language of document to be friendlier. For example, replace "mandatory" with "expected."
